Elder care in focus at expo

A lot of innovations, products and services for elderly care will be presented during InterCare Asia 2018 at Bitec Hall 106, Bang Na-Trat Road, from tomorrow until Saturday, 10am-7pm.

Organised by NCC Exhibition Organiser and the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), the third edition of the international health expo will be a stage to represent Thailand as a potential and competent place to be a medical hub for healthcare and elderly care in the region.
